**As an NMRA 100% Club the following will apply:**

1. 100% status will be valid for one year from the date that the Region Secretary approved the application.
2. 100% status is to be renewed annually.
3. The club will receive a certificate noting their attainment of 100% Club status which is to be displayed in the club premises.
4. The club Secretary or Primary Contact will receive an electronic copy of the MainLine to be distributed to the club members.
5. The club Secretary or Primary Contact will receive copies of the NMRA-AR logo which are to be displayed at all Sanctioned public events.
6. The club is required to commit to the goals of the NMRA.

**Note:** The Australasian Region's insurance provider requires that every club member be an NMRA member in good standing pursuant to clause b above. Clubs are cautioned not to maintain duplicate membership lists to "beat the system". Misrepresentation of club membership rolls can result in cancellation of insurance, possible prosecution for fraud, and possible individual personal liability for all club members and officers.
